Mike's Mindfulness

An expert in religious law asked Jesus, "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the Law of Moses?" Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself. The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments." (Matthew 22:36-40) In 1986, there was a terrible tragedy in the Black Sea off the coast of Russia. Two ships collided, throwing many into the icy waters. Hundreds died. When investigators revealed the cause of the shipwreck, it became clear that this disaster could have been avoided.

It wasn't dense fog or a technical malfunction or heavy seas. This tragedy was caused by ego.

Each captain was aware of the other ship's presence. Instead of giving way, each captain refused to steer clear, insisting the other change course. Both ships continued on course as they advanced toward each other.

By the time these captains came to their senses and realized what was at stake in this nautical game of chicken, it was too late. Each of these two captains had a high opinion of self and little regard for the other. Had they chosen to love their neighbor more and themselves less, this disaster would have been avoided. As we go about our lives, shining Christ's light into this darkened world, we should think a little less of ourselves and a little more of others. In doing so, we will become better people and the world will be a little better place.




