A Minute with Mike

Nobel prizes are awarded each year in the areas of literature, peace, economics, medicine, and the sciences. These awards are funded from the fortune of Swedish inventor Alfed Nobel. He amassed his fortune from his invention of dynamite.

It was not his original intention to give his fortune away. This change of plan came about as a result of a mistake.

When Nobel's brother died, French newspapers believed it was the inventor and ran obituaries based on that mistaken belief. One obituary described Nobel as a man who had made it possible to kill more people more quickly than anyone else who had ever lived. Another paper called him the "merchant of death."
